SNU Global Scholarship for Spring 2018

<u>Scholarship Summary</u>

- There are three types of scholarships in SNU Global Scholarship
- Applicants may apply for *more than one scholarship* among these.

□ **<u>Eligibility</u>**: International graduate students of SNU(both enrolled students and freshmen)

- □ **<u>Number of recipients</u>**: To be announced
- □ Application Period : 18 December (Mon), 2017 ~ 5 January (Fri), 2018
- □ Result Announcement : January, 2018
- * Only those who finally selected as Global Scholarship recipients will be contacted by email.

□ <u>Subsidies</u>

1) Type 1: SNU Global Scholarship 1

- : Tuition, Living Allowance (monthly KRW 1,200,000), Round-trip Airfare (only for freshman)
- * Points will be added for those with certificate of career in the public sector.
- 2) Type 2: SNU Global Scholarship 2 : Tuition

 3) Type3 : <u>Korean Language Special Program</u>
: Tuition for Korean Language evening classes at the Language Education Institute of SNU (only for 1 session)

* Applicants *should* fill in the *on-line application* for the program(*evening class*) Until <u>February 2nd(Fri.), 2018</u>.

* Applicants can choose more than one program among three options in their SNU Global Scholarship application form.

Subsidized Period: 1 year

* Scholarship may be renewed on an academic semester basis; the recipients must maintain an average grade point level of 3.0/4.3.

* Please note that the recipients of the SNU Global Scholarship Program might be restricted from taking leave of absence. For leave of absence, recipients should contact OIA and the office of representative college office.

- 2) Transcript of academic record at your final educational institution
- 3) Certificate of work experience in public sector (optional)
- 4) Recommendation letter(s) (optional)
